The next RFG 100 Insight Teleconference on "Executive Responsibility for False Security Corporate Filings and Breaches" will be on Tuesday, April 2nd at 8:30 AM EST. Dr. Dave Chatterjee, World-Renowned Tech Thought Leader and Business Strategist at the University of Georgia, has researched and authored an article entitled "Should executives go to jail over cybersecurity breaches?" The article examines proposals to impose jail terms for corporate officers who knowingly mislead the shareholders and the public about corporate security in corporate filings. This Insight Teleconference examines these issues further and will provide an opportunity for attendees to ask questions about Dr. Chatterjee's findings and conclusions. This topic is also closely aligned with ongoing RFG 100 discussions and Task Forces looking at Aggregate Risk and "Security First" corporate cultures - areas in which Dr. Chatterjee will offer his guidance and perspective.

Those of you who were able to join us at December 6th's RFG 100 Digital Business Transformation Summit will recall Dr. Chatterjee's keynote on "Cornerstones of a High Performance Security Culture." Dr. Chatterjee had presented his findings from studying successful cybersecurity organizations and identifying and validating the organizational principles and methodologies essential for high-performing cybersecurity organizations.

This Insight Teleconference will cover:

- Some of the financial and individual remunerations and retributions required for intentional security-related declarations
- An examination of proactive indicators and metrics to quantify the security of sensitive information
- Cybersecurity preparedness using operational, organizational, and cultural programmatic paradigms

In addition to the article linked above, Dr. Chatterjee has put together a detailed Q&A abstract detailing issues he intends to highlight on the Insight Teleconference. That Q&A PDF is attached here.

An upcoming panel at the next RFG 100 Digital Business Transformation Summit on April 11th in NYC will deal with the ongoing topic of quantifying aggregate risk controls/norms/thresholds. Dr. Chatterjee's discussion should be considered prerequisite in participating in those discussions. That invitation is forthcoming this week and I hope you can join us.
